To attend a Michigan community college, each year, up to three years



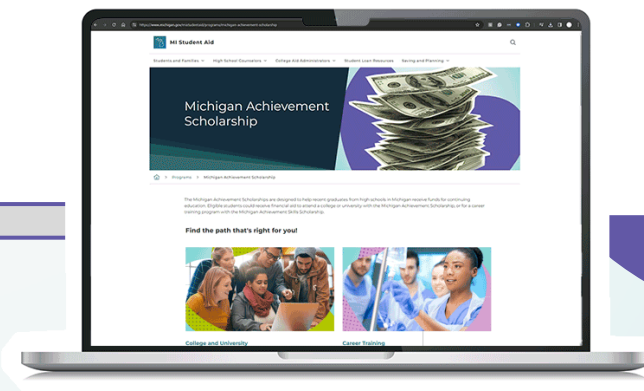

Be a Michigan resident since
July 1st of the previous year



**TO GET A
MICHIGAN ACHIEVEMENT
SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST:**

Have a Student Aid Index (SAI)
of \$30,000 or less for the 2024-25
academic year.

SAI is generated upon
completion of the FAFSA



**TO GET A
MICHIGAN ACHIEVEMENT
SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST:**

Enroll full-time at an eligible Michigan college or university within 15 months of high school graduation or earning a high school equivalency certificate.

YOU WON'T KNOW IF YOU QUALIFY UNLESS YOU FILL OUT YOUR FAFSA!

FILLING OUT THE NEW FAFSA IS EASIER THAN EVER. Seriously.

- In less time than it takes to scroll on TikTok, you could get up to **\$27,500** for college.
- It's worth completing, even if you're unsure of your future plans.
- Filling out the FAFSA doesn't commit you to anything. It's simply the first step to evaluating your funding options.



4 STEPS FOR FILLING OUT FAFSA

- 1 Memorize your social security number (SSN)



- 2 **CREATE YOUR FSA ID AT:**
FAFSA.gov

YOU'LL NEED: Your social security number & your email address.

➡ You must create a FSA ID three days before completing your FAFSA.

- 3 Ask your parents to create their own FSA ID

- 4 Fill out the FAFSA with your parents. The newly simplified form **ONLY HAS 36 QUESTIONS!**
