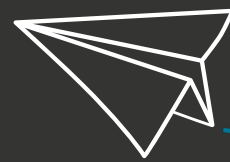


EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION IS THE PATH FOR YOU!

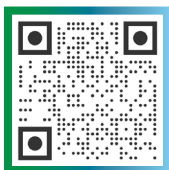
