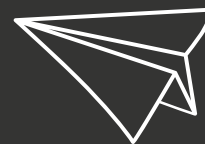


TEACH EARLY CHILDHOOD® MICHIGAN SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

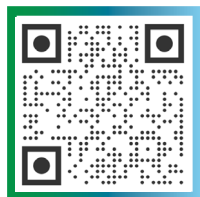


Pursue an education in early childhood at little to no cost with the **TEACH Early Childhood® scholarship program**. The Michigan Association for the Education of Young Children (AEYC) provides this scholarship opportunity to help future educators get the financial help they need to succeed.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Several scholarships are available through the program:

- **Career and Technical Education scholarship** — Supports high school students in CTE Education General to earn a Child Development Associate (CDA) or Michigan Youth Development Associate (MI-YDA) credential.
- **CDA training** — Provides scholarships to earn college credit while completing CDA requirements.
- **CDA/MI-YDA assessment** — Covers the cost of CDA or MI-YDA credential assessments.
- **Associate degree** — Funds coursework for an associate degree in early childhood education or child development.
- **Bachelor's degree** — Supports earning a bachelor's degree in early childhood education, child development or Birth to Kindergarten teaching certificate.
- **Master's degree** — Advances your career with funding for a master's degree in early childhood education, child development or Birth to Kindergarten teaching certificate.
