Graduation is right around the corner. Your senior is about to step into their bright future. Before they do, make it a little brighter by unlocking free money for college or career training by filling out the FAFSA. Whether your teen is headed to community college, university or career training (or if they're unsure of their plans), completing the FAFSA is their first step (not last step) to finding out how much money they could get for their next chapter.

Our theme this month, **Future Is Bright**, is all about celebrating our seniors and their bright futures! Students even received themed sunglasses as a reminder of sunny days ahead. Help your senior get started on their path by filling out the FAFSA.

3 STEPS TO COMPLETING THE FAFSA

1. Gather Social Security numbers and income info (like bank balances and tax returns).
2. Create [StudentAid.gov](https://studentaid.gov) accounts for you and your child.
3. Fill out the [FAFSA](https://fafsa.gov) together — it takes most families 30 minutes or less to complete!

Don't let your senior miss out on money for college or career training — including scholarships, grants, work-study funds and loans. Eligibility isn't based on GPA. And with more money available than ever — plus higher family income limits — they might qualify for more than you think!
